1. Discuss the impact you think your local Hispanic community has on your builder members.
2. What are some of the major safety issues your members address on a daily basis?
 - a. Follow-Up: Discuss how you, as an association, can better address these safety issues on behalf of your membership.
3. How do you reach out to members of the Hispanic community in your area?
4. What activities, if any, do you currently have to recruit and encourage membership from the local Hispanic Community?
 - a. Follow-Up: Brainstorm several opportunities for your association to reach out to this demographic.
5. How does the language barrier between your builder members and their crews impact daily production and profitability goals?
6. Are OSHA visits on your members' jobsites up or down from this time last year? Discuss possible circumstances to support why.
 - a. Follow-Up: Brainstorm methods and activities that you, as an association, can encourage your members to implement in order to reduce (or maintain) number of OSHA visits.
7. How would teaching English language skills to Spanish-speaking workers help improve job site conditions for your members?
8. From a safety and OSHA standpoint, discuss the benefits of creating an English-only jobsite for your members.
